## Environment & Sustainability (Experience of our organisation)

Our approach focuses on:

- Promoting active citizenship
- Using non-formal education methods such as workshops, intercultural exchanges and outdoor activities
- Encouraging young people to develop soft skills and civic engagement through sustainability projects (maximum use of public transports or soft transports when possible)

Through these activities, we aim to help young people understand that environmental sustainability and social justice are closely connected.
